

Reading Challenge – how it works!

All children are issued with a reading challenge record (this booklet)

An adult is to sign each box to confirm 10 minutes of reading has been completed.

Children can read any book of their choice. It does not have to be their school reading book!

A ration stamp is awarded and displayed on our class ration books for every 10 minutes of reading completed at home.

Children who have completed weekly reading target of 70 minutes earn a dip in class prize box!

Children who complete all 250 minutes of reading will go into a prize draw.

Bonus challenge. How many different text types can you read? Adult to sign box when completed. Puffin point awarded in class.

Completed reading challenge booklets to be handed in on **Friday 25th October** to be entered into prize draw.

There will be 1 top prize for each year group.
