Let's talk enhanced transitions

Parents and carers found out where their child will be going to Reception on the 17th of April

What you can do to support children's transition to reception:

- 1. Inform your Early Years Inclusion Consultant of children's confirmed Reception places, if they will require an enhanced transition.
- 2. Ensure that, where children are being deferred and staying with you, parents/carers have discussed this with LA School Admissions team and have had the deferral approved. Let your Early Years Inclusion Consultant know which children have had deferrals approved.
- 3. Update each child's School Readiness Passport, including the 'Reception Ready' checker (last half of Summer term) and the SEND section of All About Me where appropriate.
- 4. Transfer the children to their new school/setting on the School Readiness Passport ASAP – set the transfer date for the last day the child is with you so that you and the school have a shared view of the child's Passport throughout the Summer term to support any discussions you might have and to ensure the child's new teacher can prepare well in advance of them starting.
- 5. Where relevant, organise a meeting/visits with the child's new school and plan together how best to support an effective transition for the child's specific needs (your Early Years Inclusion Consultant can support you with these meetings if helpful). If 'Team Around the Child/Family' meetings are already taking place, invite the child's new teacher along to these ASAP.

The course aims to develop:

- understanding of the Portage Principles and model of support
- · the basic skills to deliver Portage under supervision
- the ability to apply Portage skills in one's own workplace
 knowledge of the history and local development of Portage
- knowledge of materials and resources
- confidence in working together using the Portage model
- an awareness of the National Portage Association

Central to the course are the 'Portage Principles' and the 'Three Circle Model of Portage'. These are emphasised throughout the modules of the course.

- Introduction to Portage The Portage model and its relevance in Early Years Settings
- Helping Children Learn Using Clear Language
- Helping Children Learn Planning for Success
- Helping Children Learn A Small Steps Approach
- Planning, Recording and Sharing Activities
- Supporting the Development of Play
- Positive approaches to Children's Behaviour

Do you have a child with significant or complex needs in your setting. Are you applying for EYSTAR, COSA or DAF funding. If so, you may be interested in attending the Portage Workshop.

The portage workshop offers practitioners practical advice, techniques, and strategies to be able to support not only children with SEND but for all learners.

On completion of the workshop, you will be able to link the portage principles into your current practice. Not only will we look at practical activities and techniques, but we will also look at writing specific targets using 'clear language.' This will give early years practitioners the skills to break down long term outcomes into specific short-term outcomes, to set appropriate SMART targets for SEND learners.

We hope you take advantage of the 2 and a half-day workshop to develop links with the Portage Team to support all our learners.

Participants must complete both days and half day sessions. Please do not send another member of staff if you cannot attend.









On completion of the course, you will receive certification as having been trained in Portage principles.

The total cost of the course is: £50.00 for Northumberland PVI Providers and £150.00 for Northumberland Schools.

April 2023	Transfers for new starters on the Passport Remember to share any children who have moved from your setting with their new provider, and accept any new transfers to your setting. Find out how to do this <u>here</u> .
Friday 21st July 2023	Summer term payment run If you have recently been sent an EYSTAR notification letter, you will be paid the funding on this date.
Week Beginning 22nd of May	Transitions Week Look out for important information about transitions, especially children transitioning to Reception in September.
Wednesday 25th May 2023	Final panel date for EYSTAR applications for children moving to Reception Unless the child does stretched entitlement over the summer holidays.
