

This term we have introduced a new option for claiming your estimates figures. You can now opt for either;

Spring 2019 Payment

You can choose whether to be paid monthly or by an advanced payment for the term.

Do you want to be paid monthly or in advance? Monthly Advance

1. Advanced payment - you will receive up to 75% of your EY Funding at the beginning of term and receive the remaining balance at the end of term.
2. Monthly payment - You will receive your EY Funding payments in installments throughout the term. As spring is a short term and there are 3 months for payments, the first 2 months will be at 25% with the balancing month paying 50%. This means that 50% will be paid on estimated figures and the remainder paid on actual headcount information. Every other term will be paid in 4 installments at 25% per month.

You will be asked to complete the number of children & average weekly hours for each entitlement (2 Year Olds , 3-4Year Olds (15hrs) & 3-4 Year Olds (30hrs).

Advance/Monthly Claim

How to calculate average weekly hours

Example 1 - All two-year-olds are doing 15 hours:

- 15 hours as your average

Example 2 - Nine two-year-olds to claim. Six doing 15 hours and three doing 10 hours.

- $6 \times 15 = 90 + 3 \times 10 = 30$.
- Total = 120 total weekly hours for 9 children.
- $120 / 9 = 13.33$ Average weekly hours

Example 3 - Fifteen 3-4 Year Olds (Universal entitlement) to claim. Eight doing 9 hours and Seven doing 15 hours.

- $8 \times 9 = 72 + 7 \times 15 = 105$
- Total = 105 total weekly hours for Fifteen children.
- $105 / 15 = 7$ Average weekly hours
