




Economic Impact

Preparation for Change

Key Questions:

- What impact will 80%+ of revenue from Government have on my flexibility and sustainability?
- How can I control my costs cost of living and inflation of the last 12 months that is projected to continue for the next 2 years as the changes are introduced?
- How do i optimise efficiency and maximise occupancy?
 - do I need to stretch my entitlement?
 - Increase my current stretched offer?
 - Take under 2's or 3's only?

This will encompass:

- Current model can it change?
- Registered places Physical capacity?
- Ages, funding and revenue
- Number of weeks open can I stretch my entitlement?
- Do I need to work in collaboration with others and How? – specialist under 3's
- Staffing capacity do I need to plan for recruitment?

- Data for your specific area
- Marketing creating a pipeline


