The Course

Northern Training Partnership's First Aid for Outdoor Schools Course is designed specifically for outdoor school leaders, outdoor practitioners, and anyone responsible for children in natural environments.

The training programme consists of four hours of supported blended learning which will equip participants with the confidence and competence to safely manage their settings, first aid resources and compliance for situations in woodland, coastal, farm and outdoor learning settings where medical help may be delayed.

This certification is valid for three years and is to be completed in conjunction with a full Paediatric First Aid certificate to comply with OFSTED and the Early Years Foundation Stage Document.

Certification is accredited by the First Aid Industry Body.

Relevant qualification levels for your setting should comply with Ofsted regulations and the DFE Early Years Foundation Stages

Who this course is for:

- Outdoor School leaders (Level 1-3)
- Outdoor educators and play workers
- Teachers running outdoor learning sessions
- Youth workers, rangers, and activity instructors
- Anyone supervising children in natural environments



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Content & Timescales

The syllabus focuses on First Aid elements of outdoor activities (including Forest, Beach, Farm Schools) and covers issues which may need to be addressed in an outdoor and possibly more remote geographical area.

The supplementary topics will require an additional 4 to 6 hours of learning for each candidate. The exact timescales will vary depending on the abilities of those undertaking the course.

Northern Training Partnership Ltd use a blended learning approach with topics or parts thereof being a combination of video, PDFs to read, templates and knowledge checks as well as periods of self-directed learning which includes research and putting together a report or using templates provided.
