What is The School Readiness Passport?

The Passport is an online platform which encourages collaborative partnership working to ensure all children including those with SEND are supported through:



- Effective transition
- Implementation and monitoring of actions to support progress
- Early identification of needs with the use of a robust assessment tool
- Analysis data









Benefits

- Single digital passport, accessible by all Early Years settings attended by the child.
- A system which enables early years practitioner to work collaboratively to support the child's school readiness journey.
- A system to enable multi-professionals, e.g. portage to work in partnership with the child's setting to provide holistic and integrated support.
- A system to gather a child's story the moment they begin a setting to support their transition throughout early years and into school.

For the provider...

- An easy to use robust assessment checker from 6 months old to the end
 of reception centred around child development milestones and proven
 to reduce assessment related workload.
- A refined assessment and progress tool for children identified with emerging needs and/or SEND.
- Prompts and tools to support the graduated approach.


